

JACK R. SNIDER YOUNG BAND DIRECTOR AWARD

The Jack R. Snider Young Band Director award was established in 1986 by the NSBA Executive Board and Past Presidents Council to commemorate the 25th anniversary of NSBA. The award was named for Jack Snider, who retired after a long and distinguished career that included 35 years at UNL. Winners of the award will be announced at the NSBA convention and will receive a framed certificate. They will also attend a breakfast with the selection committee on Saturday morning of the convention. It is hoped that previous winners will continue to attend the breakfast each year.

Nominees will be asked to fill out an information form giving instrumentation lists of their band, rehearsal schedules, and a list of performances at school and also, within the community. Directors must be NSBA members in their third through seventh years of teaching to be considered for this award.
