

## NSBA Band Director Scholarships

NSBA is offering **two \$300 scholarships** will be available for NSBA band directors with a minimum of three years teaching experience. Applicants must be enrolled in an instrumental music education graduate course. This course does not need to be taken at a Nebraska institution. To apply, band directors need to follow this procedure. Send to the NSBA Awards Chair the following information typed on an 8 ½" x 11" sheet of paper using no more than one and one half pages: name, school, home address, phone number, e-mail (if available), a brief description of your band program, contest and festival results, number of students, musical achievements, dates and places taught, three character qualities that you desire to develop in your students and why you consider these to be important characteristics. In the remaining space, describe what course you plan to take, the name of the college or university, where you plan to take the course, and why you are taking the course. Scholarships can be awarded to the same person more than once.

Application materials will be reviewed by a committee appointed by the NSBA President and Awards Chair. The winners will be contacted, and will be announced at the annual awards banquet.
